
You can create a free account at www.ctweather.com to receive a text message or email about our closings or delays. On their site go to "Closings & Alerts" and select "E-Notifications". Then follow the simple instructions to create an account and choose to receive notifications from MLC.

Notifications are also recorded on our telephone answering system.

256 Main Street at the corner of Library Place.

There is a parking garage directly behind the Centre on Library Place. Elevator access to the recital hall is available from the rear entrance.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Admission is free.

Please plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your section time. The dress code for performers is "neat casual", no jeans please. The recital is approximately 60-75 minutes in length. Your attention during the performances of each participant in your section is appreciated. As a courtesy to the students and to others in the audience, please consider the attendance of any children who may not be able to quietly enjoy the program. A brief reception follows each recital section.
